Dr. Gluskin graduated from the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry, San Francisco, California in 1972. He received his Endodontic Certification from Temple University in Philadelphia in 1976. He is currently Professor and Chairperson, Department of Endodontics, Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry, University of the Pacific in San Francisco, California. He is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists and the American College of Dentists.

Dr. Gluskin is a member of the American Association of Endodontists, the American Dental Association and the San Francisco Dental Society.
